

## Third Grade Summer Reading List

Please choose 2 books to read.

As you complete each book, choose a type of report to complete for each. You must choose a different type of report for each book you read.

The Chocolate Touch by Patrick Catling

Freckle Juice by Judy Blume

Chocolate Fever by Robert Kimmel Smith

Good Grief, Third Grade by Colleen McKenna

Fudge – A – Mania by Judy Blume

### Book Report choices

1. A written summary including the plot, setting, characters, and problem and how it was solved. This should be 2 paragraphs long, with 5 – 7 sentences per paragraph.
2. A movie poster showing a scene from the story (not the cover of the book) and a short summary of the main story. Include the name and author, and picture could include actors you think would play the main characters well in a movie.
3. A front page of a “news paper” with a minimum of 4 stories that explain what happened in the story. These could include: The main story – such as a picture with a title and caption, a want ad, a sales ad, and movie or book ad. These can be put together on a long piece of paper or on 2 sheets of paper taped together to resemble a newspaper page.
4. A diorama of a scene from the book. This is done on the inside of a shoe box. On the outside faces - a short summary on the top, including the name and author, characters on one side, and setting on the other.
5. Book squares – fold a sheet of plain paper into fourths. In each section draw a picture about what happened and a sentence explaining the picture. Students must have at least 8 squares. You can have more, but a minimum of 8 is required.
6. A book jacket – create a new cover for the front and back of the book. This should include the name of the book, author, a picture or two that are different from the original book’s cover, and a summary of the story including the main character and story line.
